


EU Deforestation Regulation (EUDR)

The EU aims to better protect existing forests from deforestation and forest degradation with the EUDR. Therefore, companies in the EU may only sell their products if they can be proven to be free from deforestation.

Affected raw materials:

cattle and leather of cattle, cocoa, coffee, oil palm, rubber, soya, wood.



What needs to be done?

1. Are regulated raw materials included in your products?
2. Do you have the necessary due diligence statements from your suppliers?
3. Are you importing products that contain affected raw materials into the EU? Do you need to fulfill the due diligence requirements?
4. Are you communicating the necessary due diligence statements within your supply chain?

When does the EUDR come into effect?

The EUDR came into force on 29 June 2023 and will become fully effective on 30 December 2025.
